

ELECTION BOARD

The following persons have been appointed to the Election Board of the Iowa Tribe of Kansas & Nebraska: Nina Merchant, Becky Ogden, and Linda Schuetz.

The Election Board will handle all the Election procedures, including the filing of candidates, announcements, and tabulating the results.

IOWA TRIBAL RODEO

The First Annual Iowa Tribal Rodeo was held this past June 6th & 7th.

Even though there was a terrific amount of expense involved the first year, the Executive Committee feels that it was a success.

It will take several years before we can start realizing a profit from the Rodeo, because of the initial investment.

The Executive Committee has been discussing building a permanent arena and chutes. We feel that it would be much safer than the portable equipment used this past year.

The Rodeo has tentatively been scheduled for the same weekend next year. This being the first weekend in June.

JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT

The J.T.P.A. Program is funded by the Department of Labor and is administered by United Tribes of Kansas and Southeast Nebraska.

The Iowa Tribe currently is utilizing four people who are employed on this Program.

The requirements of this Program are the participant can only work 1,000 hours. After one participant works 1,000 hours, he must be replaced by another who will then be eligible for 1,000 hours, etc.

The balance of the employees are employed through grants and contracts administered by the Iowa Tribe.

CUTS IN GRANTS AND CONTRACTS

During Fiscal Year 1986, the Iowa Tribe received an approximate \$15,000.00 cut in their Grants and Contracts.

These cuts were due to the Gramm-Rudman-Hollings Bill that was passed by Congress. We anticipate the same cuts in Fiscal Year 1987.

So far, we have been able to operate without cutting services a great deal.

Indian Health Service is feeling the effects of Gramm-Rudman cuts tremendously. These cuts however, do effect services to the Indian people.

AUDIT

The Executive Committee takes a great deal of pride in stating that we again received a 100% clean audit for the past Fiscal Year.

We are audited by Prosser and Prosser P.C.A. on an annual basis.

ROADS AND CEMETERIES

Due to an eight inch rain that we received a couple of weeks ago, our roads were washed badly.

The employees have been working to get them back into shape. We have been fixing washed out culverts and replacing the gravel that washed away. This was one of the most damaging rains we have seen here.

We have been behind in caring for the cemeteries, also due to the heavy rains we received in the month of August.

We plan to get them in shape within the next week.

PROPOSED PRINTING BUSINESS

Stephen McGiffert, Attorney for the Iowa Tribe, will be present to discuss the Printing Operation with the Tribal members.

There has been a management agreement and the Articles of Incorporation presented for review. The Attorney is reviewing these at this time.

FARM OPERATION

The crops looked great until about two weeks ago. They were badly damaged by a hail storm. The corn crop didn't get hurt too bad, but the soybeans were damaged rather badly.

We were covered by crop insurance so we will get paid for our losses.

Because of the sagging farm economy, we are changing our Farm Program a little. We are seeding more ground to clover and alfalfa to eliminate some of the cost of fertilizing and chemicals.

The Tribe has always maintained a profit in its Farm Operation, however this year doesn't look good so far. Corn presently being worth \$1.30 a bushel doesn't help the profit picture.

The thing that helps our Farm Operation is that we are free of and debt. Machinery and crops are all paid for.

We are still paying for the Nanomantube Farm but have had no problem in doing so. We can only hope for a better year next year.

HOLTON HEALTH FACILITY

We held a community meeting August 18, 1986. The purpose of the meeting was to allow concerned citizens to publicly express their concerns or opinions on "Proposed Indian Health Service Eligibility Changes in order to qualify for services." We had in attendance representatives from Indian Health Service. 94 interested persons attended this meeting. All the comments were opposing the changes and especially the blood quantum requirement. We had one person approve the changes.

If this proposed change passes and becomes law, it will disqualify approximately 60% of our people who use the clinics. It probably will cause us to lose our Satellite Clinic in White Cloud. This will cause a severe impact on the health of our Tribal members now and in the future years. We urge you to send written comments on this important issue.

BINGO ENTERPRISE

Our Bingo Operation has proven to be a successful economic development business on the Reservation.

We have bingo sessions Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings and Sunday afternoons. The attendance is between 180 to 230 per session. We employ 1 full-time manager and 9 part-time employees from the Reservation and surrounding communities. The Bingo Operation helps the economy both on and adjacent to the Reservation.

TRIBAL ENROLLMENT

We have been up-dating our Tribal enrollment by keeping addresses and names current. We still have a lot of addresses unknown. We would appreciate any help you can give us in providing current addresses.

We are now in the process of providing new enrollment numbers to all Tribal members. The Bureau of Indian Affairs required that our enrollment numbers match the ones assigned by B.I.A. All Tribal members will receive their new identification card by mail. The ones returned with addresses unknown will be kept on file.

PROPOSED HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- (a) Be a member of (or eligible for membership in) a federally recognized tribe.
- (b) Be of one fourth (1/4) or more Indian or Alaska Native.
- (c) Reside within a designated health service delivery area.
- (d) If a person is not a member of, or eligible for membership in a federally recognized tribe, the person must be 1/2 or more Indian or Alaska Native and reside within the designated service area to qualify for IHS services.


