#### **Meeting Expectations and Decorum:**

- This is an informational meeting, and as such no general council business is conducted at this meeting.
- All materials posted in the Members only section of the website and shared during the meeting are confidential and is not to be shared with anyone outside the Tribe. Some of these financials are proprietary information that can have a negative impact on tribal businesses if competitors see the data.
- Meetings of the General Council shall be conducted in an orderly manner to ensure that the membership has a full opportunity to be heard and that the deliberative process of the Council is retained at all times. The Executive Committee and their designees shall be responsible for maintaining the order and decorum of meetings.
- General Council members shall treat each other with respect, and shall not: Use profanity, interrupt others, heckle or threaten others, disrespect property, exhibit behavior that disrupts the meeting or that endangers the safety of other attendees, be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs, have a weapon on their person in violation of any applicable law, take action that violates any law of the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska.
- In order to maintain accurate meetings minutes in council meetings, all speakers must proceed to the microphone and introduce themselves by first and last names prior to asking questions or making comments.
