

**Job Summary:**

The Noxious Weed Sprayer will be vital in supporting the Conservation with the Fish and Wildlife Department. The role will be responsible for managing the noxious weed and invasive plant species on Iowa Tribe land. The role aligns with the tribe's vision of creating a healthier environment and ecosystem where biodiversity can flourish on tribal lands.

Hours: Seasonal PT Role (Up to 30hrs per week)

Compensation: \$25/hr

Role Reports To: Conservation Officer

Description of Responsibilities:

- Managing storage of chemicals with ability to mix and distribute hazardous chemicals for noxious weeds.
- Creating reports of work day and treated areas. Reporting into Conservation Officer
- Keep common areas free from noxious weeds and/or unwanted debris
- Identify and remove noxious weeds as needed
- Operating UTV to complete daily task

- High School Diploma preferred but not required

Work Experience:

- Previous experience a plus/preferred but not required

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Will need to pass background check and drug screening.
- Work well under little supervision
- Great at time management
- Ability to lift up to 50lbs
- Ability to lift, bend, stoop, sit, and stand
- Must be a self-starter
- Must possess excellent verbal and written communication skills.

- Must have the ability to manage time and multiple projects efficiently and achieve the required results.
- Must be able to work in all inclement weather conditions
