



Position Title: Greenhouse - Lead

Schedule: Monday-Friday 8:00 A.M.- 4:30 P.M. (40 hours per week, may include evenings and weekends as needed)

Overview:

We are seeking a diligent regenerative agricultural laborer to work primarily with our greenhouse as the lead position. The Greenhouse Leader's responsibilities include providing daily care to greenhouse and nursery plants to include planting, transplanting, pruning, watering, fertilizing, controlling insects and disease, ventilating, and controlling weeds; manage plant nutrient levels. Maintain each greenhouse room at the appropriate temperature, humidity, and light level.

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Maintain appropriate temperature, humidity, and light levels for greenhouses
- Control ventilation and insect control
- Identify customer base and potential clients for products produced by greenhouse and gardens
- Plan layout and planting of garden with specific vegetables in mind for consumers and tribal needs. This will include early season crops such as potatoes, onions, cabbage, broccoli, beets, and other varieties of green leafy crops
- Plant Summer annuals such as tomatoes, squash, zucchini, okra, cucumbers, corn, and other crops for the casino. Start vegetables in the greenhouse in late winter/early spring for transplanting.
- Plant, harvest, and deliver crops at appropriate times.
- Order appropriate vegetable seeds and equipment needed for successful crop
- Upkeep on greenhouses, such as cleaning and servicing
- Water / Weed / Fertilize garden as required for a satisfactory crop
- May assist other loway Farm projects as needed
- Supervisory duties for greenhouse workers
- Upkeep, plant, and harvest of orchard
- Work in extreme temperatures
- Other duties as assigned

- Previous work experience as an agricultural laborer or similar role

- Able to operate and service farm machinery
- Physical strength and stamina
- Ability to work in all weather conditions
- Good organizational skills
