- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe Executive Committee being duly organized met in Special Session this 19th day of April 2022; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Executive Committee has authority to act for the Iowa Tribe under the present Constitutional authority as provided in Sec. 1.a., Article IV - Governing Bodies; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska being organized and empowered by their Constitution and Bylaws (approved November 6, 1978 and amended August 27, 1980); and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska has the authority to negotiate with the Federal government and to conclude contracts, grants, or other agreements pursuant to Article V, Section 1.a. of the Constitution; and,
- WHEREAS, The Executive Committee is seeking to apply for a EDAARPA Indigenous Grant; and,
- WHEREAS, The Executive Committee is committed to developing the Design and Demonstration of a Resilient Community Microgrid for the Iowa Tribe Energy System; and,
- WHEREAS, The Executive Committee is committed to the cost share requisite of this project; and,
- WHEREAS, Funds for the requisite cost share will derive from tribal funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska Executive Committee is submitting a grant proposal for the EDAARPA Indigenous Grant and we are committed to the requisite cost share associated with the grant.
