- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska Executive Committee being duly organized met in Regular Session this 17th day of August, 2022; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe Executive Committee has authority to act for the Iowa Tribe under the present Constitutional authority, as provided in Sec. 2, Article IV - Governing Bodies; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska being organized and empowered by their Constitution and Bylaws (approved November 6, 1978, and amended August 27, 1980); and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe Executive Committee has reviewed the FY 2022 Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) Agreement between the United States Department of the Interior Bureau of Indian Affairs which authorizes the Tribe to perform the planning, research, design, engineering, construction and maintenance of highway, road, bridge, parkway and transit facility programs and projects located on or which provide access to the Tribe and/or Tribal members; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe Executive Committee approves the FY 2022 Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) Agreement because it provides the 1) transfer to the tribe all the functions and duties that the Secretary of the Interior would have performed with respect to a program or project under 23 U.S.C. sec. 201-204, other than those functions and duties that cannot be legally transferred under the 23 U.S.C. sec 202(d)(3), together with such additional activities as the tribe may perform under the STRA-21 Act and the Tribal Transportation Program regulations; 2) the Tribe to carry out the statutory requirements pursuant to the STRA-21 Act and to maintain and improve its unique and continuing government-to-government relationship with and responsibility to the Tribe; and 3) Tribal Transportation Program funding to the Tribe or its designee, under this agreement, its formula share of Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) funds under the TTP Program; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe Executive Committee agrees to the terms, provisions and conditions of the FY 2022 Tribal Transportation Program Agreement which shall become effective upon the date of its approval and execution of the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska and the authorized BIA official and shall for the maximum period authorized by the STRA-21 Act and statutory extensions therefore; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Iowa Tribe Executive Committee hereby approves and authorizes the FY 2022 Tribal Transportation Program Agreement between the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska and the United States Department of the Interior Bureau of Indian Affairs.

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, That the chairman is hereby authorized to sign and execute any documents related to this resolution, as necessary to accomplish and enact provisions for the welfare of the Tribal People.
