- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska Executive Committee being duly organized, met in Special Session this 19th day of October, 2022; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Executive Committee has authority to act for the Iowa Tribe under the present Constitutional Authority as provided in Section 1.a., Article V - Powers; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska being organized and empowered by their Constitution and Bylaws (approved November 6, 1978 and amended August 27, 1980); and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska recognizes the need for programs that promote the stability and security of Indian children and families; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska has reorganized their service services department to be directly supervised and administered by the Tribe instead of Native American Family Services, Inc.; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska is charged with responsibility in seeking funding for the development of programs and services; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska has completed and is submitting the Indian Child Welfare Contract and the Social Service Contract to the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the undersigned Executive Committee does hereby resolve to affirm the submission of the grant application for the purpose of funding the social services department, now supervised and administered by the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska.
