- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska Executive Committee being duly organized met in Special Session this 15th day of December, 2022; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe Executive Committee has authority to act for the Iowa Tribe under the present Constitutional authority, as provided in Sec. 2, Article IV - Governing Bodies; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska being organized and empowered by their Constitution and Bylaws (approved November 6, 1978, and amended August 27, 1980); and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska acknowledges that nutrition services, supportive services, and a caregiver program are desirable benefits for tribal elders; and,
- WHEREAS, The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration on Aging is accepting grant applications for the Title VI Nutrition and Supportive Services and Native American Caregiver Support Program; and,
- WHEREAS, The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska desires to apply for Part A Grants for Native Americans and Part C Grants for the Native American Caregiver Support Program for the fiscal year 2023-2026; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska is submitting a grant application for Nutrition and Supportive Services and Caregiver Support Program through the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration on Aging.
