- WHEREAS,** The Iowa Executive Committee being duly organized met in Special Session this 8th day of May, 2024; and,
- WHEREAS,** The Iowa Tribe Executive Committee has authority to act for the Iowa Tribe under the present Constitutional authority as provided in Sec. 1.a., Article V - Powers; and,
- WHEREAS,** The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska being organized and empowered by their Constitution and Bylaws (approved November 6, 1978, and amended August 27, 1980); and,
- WHEREAS,** The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska has previously submitted a proposal under the Bureau's Endangered Species program that was funded for the restoration of the Quail population on the Iowa Tribe's reservation; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs extend the existing Endangered Species Program Grant #A17AV00485 to expend the remaining funds.
