Governor Laura Kelly's 2025 State of the State Address:

Water Conservation

Education

Child Care

Addressing the challenges faced by working families, Governor Kelly proposed the creation of an Office of Early Childhood. This initiative aims to streamline services and support for childcare providers and parents, making it easier to access quality early childhood education and care. For our Tribe, accessible and affordable childcare is crucial for the well-being of our families and the development of our youngest members. We are optimistic that this proposal will lead to resources and support that benefit our community directly.

Nutrition: Free School Lunches

In a significant move to support child nutrition, Governor Kelly proposed allocating \$5.5 million to provide free school lunches to over 35,000 Kansas students who currently qualify for reduced-price meals. This initiative aims to ensure that more children have access to nutritious meals during the school day, which is essential for their health and academic success. Many of these students reside in rural areas, and this program could have a substantial impact on families within our Tribe. By alleviating the financial burden of school meals, the proposal supports our community's efforts to promote the well-being and educational attainment of our children.
