Secretaries Report

I would like to take this time to remind you of the programs that are available. The enrollment office handles all enrollment applications, Lynn Roubidoux Scholarships, burial assistance, and eye glass vouchers.

The Lynn Roubidoux Scholarship is a one-time award that is available to high school seniors in the amount of \$3,000.00. This scholarship is for graduating seniors and must be turned in by April 15th of their senior year. This year we gave 27 scholarships in the amount of \$3,000.00 for a total of \$81,000.00.

The burial assistance is in the amount of \$4,000.00. This assistance is paid directly to the funeral home for funeral expenses. So far this year we have assisted 10 families with burial assistance for a total of \$40,000.00.

Eye glass vouchers are available for tribal members that live in the service area. This voucher is good for \$300.00 and is renewable every two years. Our total for 2014/2015 was \$64,861.15.

Since January 1st we have enrolled 44 new members to the tribal enrollment. This brings the total enrollment to 4567.

In October 2014 we applied for a Boys and Girls charter through the Boys and Girls Club of America. On May 18, 2015 we received our charter and are now classified as the Boys and Girls Club of the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska. We service the Hiawatha, Doniphan West and Falls City School Districts. We do require a membership application which you will find on the next two pages of the newsletter. We are still in the early stages and will notify all members when we are up and running in full swing. The Boys and Girls Club of America provides funding yearly. We are also applying for grants to help support our club. We will be offering tutoring, science projects, reading programs, health programs, and athletic programs.

Also this year we are hosting our second annula trunk or treat on October 24, 2015 in which we will be having a haunted trail. The Falls City, Doniphan West and Hiawatha Drama Clubs will be helping us out with the trail.
