The Ioway Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska is now accepting applications for Board Member positions on the newly established Ioway Community Development Corporation (Ioway Community Enterprises, Inc. – ICEI), a tribally chartered 501(c)(3) nonprofit.

ICEI was created to strengthen the Tribe's efforts in community development, cultural preservation, and economic opportunity. The Board of Trustees will play a vital leadership role in shaping the future of ICEI through strategic oversight, financial stewardship, and community engagement.

Key Details:

- **Position:** Board of Trustees Member (Volunteer)
- **Term:** Two years
- **Eligibility:** Open to individuals committed to serving the Tribe's mission and values; individuals involved in leadership roles with the Tribe's economic development or for-profit entities are not eligible due to conflict of interest policies.

Ideal Candidates Will:

- Demonstrate a commitment to the Ioway Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska and its citizens
- Have experience or interest in nonprofit governance, community development, culture, education, health, or economic initiatives
- Be willing to actively participate in board meetings, committees, and fundraising efforts

This is a volunteer opportunity. Travel and other expenses related to board duties may be reimbursed.
