Approval of the Minutes

1. Ron has added several pieces of new equipment also several new hives.
2. Ron has had \$600,000.00 in growth from last year so the asking price has gone up to \$3,400,000.00.
3. Ron says he only went up to cover the cost of the \$600,000.00 worth of additions.
4. He has a house at 921 Fulton Street in Falls City that goes with the sale. Ron currently houses one of his beekeepers in the home.
5. He would like to do something as 95% tribally owned and 5% owned by Ron for five years. Ron will continue to run the company on his 5% ownership.
6. He is also willing to rent the Texas home for \$125.00 per day for the crew while they are down in Texas moving bees.
7. Ron says if we are going to move on this, he wants to finish it up by the end of the year.

Old Business

Daycare Update

We will have a lease agreement put together next Wednesday for Bobbie to look over and decide if she will be moving forward. Tony will call and discuss this with Steve. There will be a \$75.00 per month payment from Bobbie to the tribe for the lease and the tribe will cover all the insurance due to all the property belonging to the tribe. Bobbie will be responsible for all the utilities at the daycare.

General Manager

The interviews were last week and the reason the one applicant did not show up was she had the date wrong. All agree not to set up another interview with her. Tony mentioned that most of the job duties are the same as the tribal administrator. All agree to discuss this again next week.

Robert says Moss Adams is very frustrated with Yahya. Yahya told Robert again that he would have everything to Moss Adams by Friday of this week. They will have a meeting with Robert, Moss Adams, and Yahya on Friday.

FTZ Invoice

This has not been paid due to not getting the audit information from Yahya. Tim explained that this is for the FTZ activation and not for accounting so we will need to pay for it. Robert says he will get this paid today.

Resolution 25-R-28 Jackpot Account

Brad motions to approve resolution 25-R-28. Robert seconded the motion. This motion carried 3-for, 0-opposed.
