- WHEREAS,** The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska Executive Committee being duly organized, met in Regular Session this 4<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2026; and,
- WHEREAS,** The Iowa Executive Committee has authority to act for the Iowa Tribe under the present Constitutional Authority as provided in Section 1.a., Article V - Powers; and,
- WHEREAS,** The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska being organized and empowered by their Constitution and Bylaws (approved November 6, 1978 and amended August 27, 1980); and,
- WHEREAS,** The Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized under the Act of June 18, 1934, (USC 476) as amended; and,
- WHEREAS,** After significant consideration of the law enforcement resources of the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska, the history of charges and convictions of sex offenders under Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska law, and funding to establish an office for registration, the Iowa Tribal Executive Committee has elected to “Opt Out” of participating as a registration jurisdiction in the National Sex Offender Registration and Notification System as outlined in Section 127 of PL, 109-248; and,
- WHEREAS,** The Tribal Executive Committee has determined, that the overall best interest of the Iowa Tribe of Kansas and Nebraska community and the tribe are best served by referring the offender registration and notification responsibilities to the State of Kansas through the Brown County Sheriff’s Department.
- WHEREAS,** The Iowa Tribal Executive Committee has reviewed the Sex Offender Registration “Opt Out” process and has voted to approve the process.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Iowa Tribal Executive Committee hereby expressly, unequivocally, and irrevocably approve the “Opt Out” Sex Offender Registration process; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that any prior policies, ordinances, legislation, or other Tribal Laws that are contrary to or inconsistent with the “opt Out” Sex Offender Registration process are hereby declared to be inapplicable and void to the extent of any such conflict or inconsistency.
