Level of Responsibility: Reports to the Iowa Tribe's Executive Committee

Minimum Qualifications:

- Knowledge of the Tribal Gaming Compact-Regulations, and the National Indian Gaming Commission's MIC's
- Possess strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Previous casino gaming experience necessary
- Computer experience
- Proficient writing, and grammar skills
- Will be on-call some nights and weekends
- Must sign confidentiality agreement
- Supervisory skills
- High School diploma or equivalent required
- Be able to pass extensive background check
- Must pass a drug test

RESPONSIBILITIES (included but not limited to):

- Enforcing Tribal Law with respect to each tribal gaming activity or operation conducted on tribal land, including regulation of any management contractors, manufacturer/distributors and all gaming employees.
- Investigations of any reported violations
- To grant, suspend or revoke gaming licenses
- To monitor and oversee the operation and conduct of all Gaming Activity
- To inspect, examine, copy and audit all papers, books, and records respecting gross receipts of gaming activities.
