Summary: White Cloud Health Center is currently seeking a dedicated and experienced LPN or RN Public Health Nurse/SDPI Coordinator/Clinic Nurse to join our team at White Cloud Health Center. As a nurse specializing in public health, the successful candidate will be responsible for managing and providing direct nursing care services in diverse settings, including clinic, homes, and community outreach events. Key responsibilities include coordinating and delivering nursing care in clinical and home settings, as well as overseeing and organizing outreach events such as health fairs, flu clinics, and educational programs. The ideal candidate will demonstrate proficiency in fulfilling mandatory reporting requirements for the Indian Health Service and managing the Special Diabetes Program for Indians grant funding.

Qualifications:

Comprehensive knowledge and experience using Electronic Health Records

- Knowledge of, and skill to understand nursing principles, practices and procedures; patient disease entities; patient plan of care; medical equipment, medical materials and supplies for the purpose of carrying out nursing services for a selected assigned complex patient with a wide variety of conditions. Ability to integrate and collaborate with patient/family the physical, spiritual, psycho/social, age specific and cultural aspects of patient care.
- Knowledge of a variety of nursing specialization to assist with the operation of specialty clinics within the outpatient department.
- Knowledge and understanding of disease processes to integrate patient and family education in the areas of health promotion and disease prevention. Ability to coordinate the health care needs of patients.
- Knowledge of pharmaceuticals, desired effects, side effects and complications and route of administration.
- Knowledge and skill sufficient to observe and identify the patient's physical and emotional problems with nursing services, medications and equipment.
- Knowledge of and skill to recognize deviations from normal sufficient to warrant immediate modification of the patient's plan of care.
- Knowledge of human behavior, and skill sufficient to understand motivations and reactions to stress for the purpose of promoting interpersonal relations with patients and family members and for the purpose of changing behavior to improve patient's health.
- Knowledge of basic life support and ability to assist in the resuscitation and stabilization of emergent patients.
- Skills to perform basic laboratory tests and nursing procedures such as venous blood draws, blood glucose, HgbA1c, throat cultures, stool cultures, rectal swabs, urine dipsticks and catheterizations.
- Skills to operate/perform and monitor a variety of medical equipment such as 12 lead EKG, fetal monitor, pulse oximeter, spirometry, nebulizers, doppler, etc.

- Conducts visits to the home, schools, community center, jail, and clinic to provide public health nurse services promoting health education
- Promotes health promotion and disease prevention education by participating in community outreaches and events
- Ability to get along with others
- Ability to take direction
